**Resolution 2780 (2025)****Adopted by the Security Council at its 9925th meeting, on  
29 May 2025**

*The Security Council,*

*Recalling* its resolution [1970 \(2011\)](#) imposing the arms embargo on Libya and all its subsequent relevant resolutions,

*Recalling* its resolutions [2292 \(2016\)](#), [2357 \(2017\)](#), [2420 \(2018\)](#), [2473 \(2019\)](#), [2526 \(2020\)](#), [2578 \(2021\)](#), [2635 \(2022\)](#), [2684 \(2023\)](#) and [2733 \(2024\)](#) concerning the strict implementation of the arms embargo on the high seas off the coast of Libya,

*Reaffirming* its resolution [2755 \(2024\)](#),

*Acting* under Chapter VII of the Charter of the United Nations,

1. *Decides* to extend the authorizations as set out in resolution [2733 \(2024\)](#) for a further 6 months from the date of this resolution;
2. *Requests* the Secretary-General to report to the Security Council within five months of the adoption of this resolution on its implementation;
3. *Decides* to remain actively seized of the matter.
